SUBJECT: Group 3 VHF Radio Net Schedule

The Group 3 VHF Radio Net Schedule is presented in the text of this email. Squadron Commander should ensure that their squadron communications personnel perform the following tasks:

1. Operate the VHF Radio Net Alternate Net Control Station (ANCS) on the assigned evenings. ANCS responsibility is rotated around the group to the squadrons with operational radio equipment. If you cannot meet your ANCS assignment, Contact another Group 3 squadron that meets on the same night and ask them to run the ANCS. LAST RESORT is to contact Major Pleasants to see if he can operate the ANCS for your squadron on that evening.
2. Check in to the VHF Radio Net as often as practical. At least once each week is desired. Twice each month is required.
3. Inactive stations will be required to turn in equipment so that the equipment can be redistributed to personnel who will use it more frequently.
